WHO'S THE CLIENT

- ► Rule I.13 (Organization as Client)
 - ▶ The City
 - "Duly authorized directors, officers, employees, members, shareholders or other constituents"
 - ▶ Public, electeds, employees

REPORT UP OBLIGATIONS

- ► Rule I.13 (Organization as Client)
 - ▶ Report up, but not out
 - Constituent violating law and
 - Action likely to substantially injure organization
 - "Governmental entity" exclusion(?)

CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

- Rule 1.6 (Confidential information of a client)
 - No whistleblower protection
 - ▶ Grand juries?
 - ▶ Who's the client?

ADVISOR

- ► Rule 2.1 (Advisor)
 - Scope of advice can include moral, economic, social and political factors

ASSISTING VIOLATIONS

- Rule 1.2.1 (Assisting, Soliciting or Inducing Violations)
 - ► Cannabis Rule
 - Other "violations"

LITIGATION

- Rule 3.1 (Meritorious Claims and Contentions)
 - ▶ Meritorious claim v. zealous representation

TRIAL PUBLICITY

- ► Rule 3.6 (Trial Publicity)
 - Limitation on statements that lawyer knows or reasonably should know has substantial likelihood of prejudicing

LAWYER AS WITNESS

- ► Rule 3.7 (Lawyer as Witness)
 - Must get permission from the boss

PROSECUTOR

- Prosecutor) and 3.10 (Threatening Criminal, Administrative, or Disciplinary Charges)
 - Discipline for poor supervision
 - ▶ Release/dismissal agreements OK

SUPERVISOR OBLIGATIONS

- ► Rules 5.1-5.3
 - Duty to take steps to ensure compliance with rules by subordinates
 - Duty to cure potential violations
 - Duty to question supervisors

EX PARTE IN ADMIN HEARING

- Rule 3.5 (Contact with Judges, Officials, Employees and Jurors)
 - Unrepresented can communicate with "adjudicatory" body

CONTACT WITH REPRESENTED PERSON

- Rule 4.2 (Communication with a Represented Person)
 - "Public Officials" can be contacted by outside lawyers
 - For employees, depends upon involvement in matter

SEX WITH CLIENT

- Rule I.8.10 (Sexual Relations with Current Client)
 - Applies to "assigners of work"

CONFLICTS WITH NEW HIRES

- ▶ Rules 1.9 (Duties to Former Clients) and 1.11 (Special Conflicts of Interest for Former and Current Government Officials and Employees)
 - ▶ Ethical walls
 - Private to private
 - ► Government to private
 - ▶ Unclear private to government

COMPETENCE

- ► Rule I.I* (Competence)
 - ► Applies to technology (?!)

HIRING OUTSIDE COUNSEL

- Rule 8.4.1 (Prohibited Discrimination, Harassment and Retaliation)
 - No harassment, discrimination
 - Practices/policies re outside counsel
